BELIEVE with all your heart!

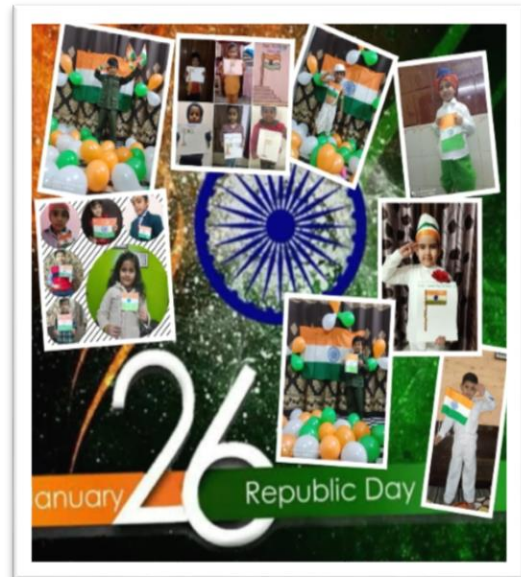
ACHIEVE with all your might!

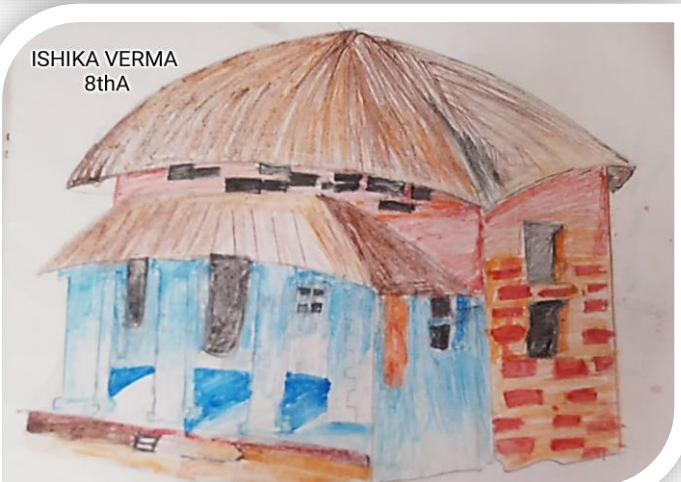
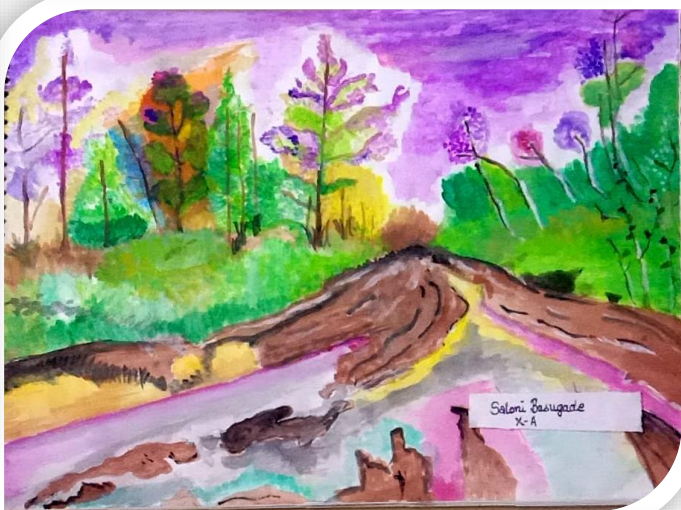
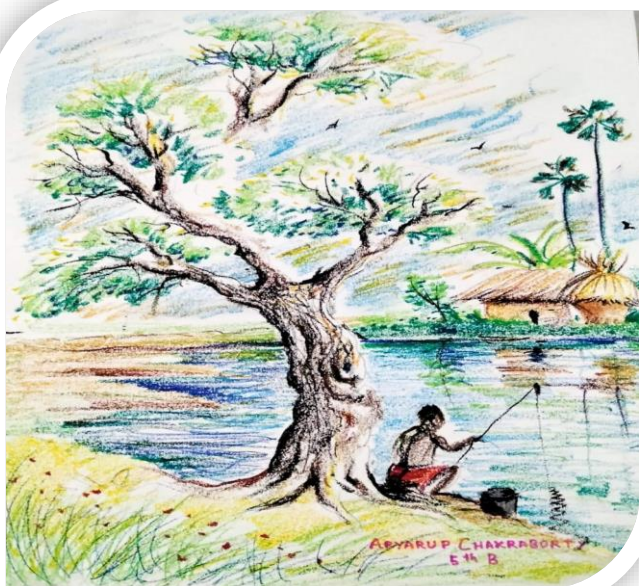
To come on online platforms from well settled offline platforms was an immediate transition. It took so much effort from students as well as teachers to adapt to this new method.
