
There were a few activities in these months along with the First Term Exams in September. Let's enjoy this transition of caterpillar and browse through this edition....

thought through a small programme in which there were songs, dance and a small skit which was organised virtually. They made videos of planting saplings in their vicinity with their family members.




INDEPENDENCE DAY (AUGUST 15, 2021)

It was a virtual celebration which included cultural dance, patriotic songs and regional flavour by students, teachers, and an inspiring message by management too.










SENIOR CITIZENS DAY (AUGUST 21, 2021)








TEACHERS' DAY (SEPTEMBER 04, 2021)

Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav


