Be happy and not perfect."




RAKSHA BANDHAN


JANAMASHTAMI


NATIONAL SPORTS DAY

हिंदी दिवस

" निज भाषा उन्नित अहै, सब उन्नित को मूल निज भाषा उन्नित बिन मिटत न हिय को शूल। "

निज भाषा अर्थात् हमारी अपनी भाषा जो हमारी आम बोलचाल एवं काम- काज की भाषा है।

निज भाषा की उन्नित का यह आहवान हिंदी भाषी जनसमूह के जातीय स्वत्व की पहचान और देशभिक्तपूर्ण आंतरिकता के साथ राष्ट्रीयता , स्वदेशी की भावना और जातीय नवोत्थान की व्याकुलता को भी दर्शाता है।

भारत में विभिन्न भाषिक समुदायों के लोग सौहार्द के साथ रहते है। भारत की यह बहुआषिकता इसकी विविधताओं में एकता की संस्कृति को तो दर्शाती ही है, साथ ही सबको एक सूत्र में बांधने के लिए किसी एक भाषा को चुनने की चुनौती भी देती है।

साल 1947 में जब भारत आजाद हुआ तो देश के सामने एक राजभाषा के चुनाव को लेकर सबसे बड़ा सवाल था, क्योंकि भारत में हजारों भाषाएं और सेकड़ो बोलिया बोली जाती हैं। इसे ध्यान में रखते हुए 14 सितंबर 1949 को निर्णय लिया गया की संघ की राजभाषा हिंदी और लिपि देवनागरी होगी। भारत

के संविधान ने देवनागरी लिपि में लिखित हिंदी को 1950 के अनुच्छेद 343 के तहत देश की आधिकारिक भाषा के रूप में 1950 में अपनाया। वहीं राष्ट्रभाषा प्रचार समिति के अनुरोध पर 14 सितंबर 1953 को पहली बार हिंदी दिवस मनाया गया। इसके बाद से प्रत्येक वर्ष 14 सितंबर को हिंदी दिवस मनाया जाता है। इसका उद्देश्य लोगों को हिंदी के महत्व व इतिहास के बारे में बताना है और अपनी मातृ भाषा के प्रति जागृत करना है। तथा हिंदी को ना केवल देश के हर क्षेत्र में बल्कि वैश्विक स्तर पर भी प्रसारित करना है।

हिंदी भाषा में सभी भावों को भरने और व्यक्त करने की अद्भुत क्षमता है, यही कारण है कि हिंदी को भारत की जननी भाषा कहा जाता है। भारतीय संस्कृति में हिंदी को मातृ भाषा का दर्जा दिया गया है। यह महज भाषा नहीं बल्कि भारतीयों को एकता व अखंडता के सूत्र में पिरोती है। हिंदी को मन की भाषा कहा जाता है, जो कश्मीर से लेकर कन्याकुमारी, संसद से लेकर सड़कों तक और साहित्य से लेकर सिनेमा तक हर जगह संवाद का सबसे बड़ा पुल बनकर सामने आती है।
