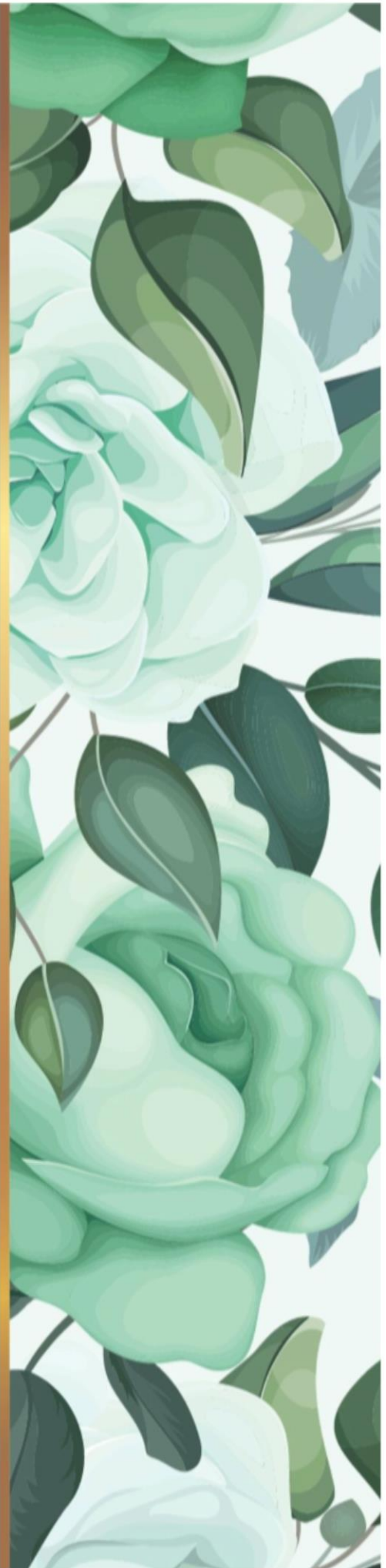

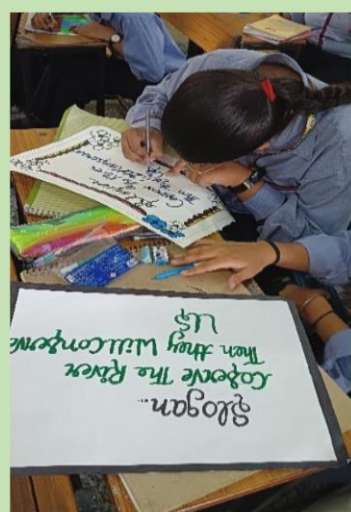


## CLEAN RIVER PROJECT 12<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER, 2022

*"We are each other's harvest,*

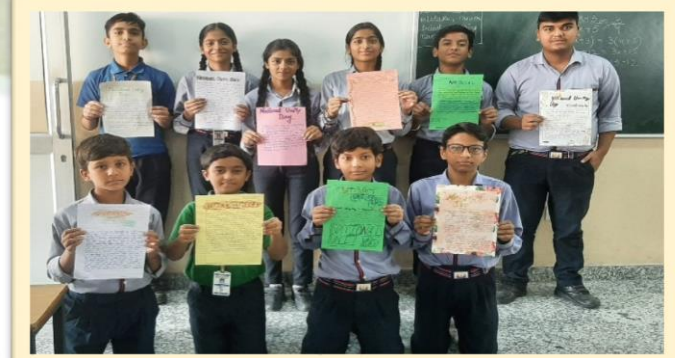

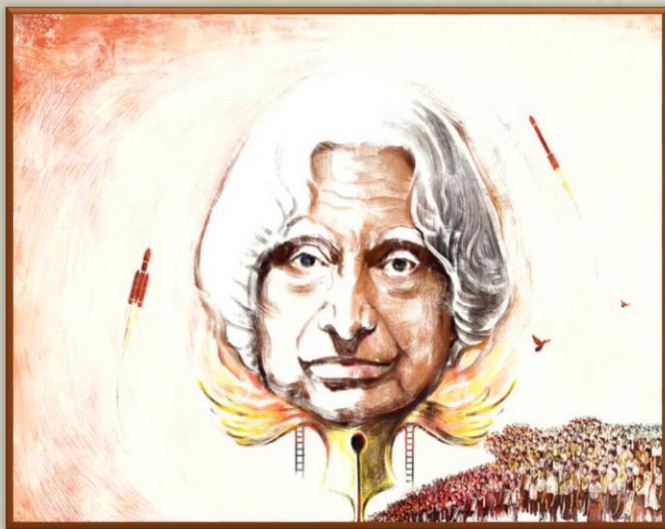
- The students of class PS to II went to Funky Island at Pacific Mall on 11 November 2022.

*Winter is not a season, it's a celebration!!*

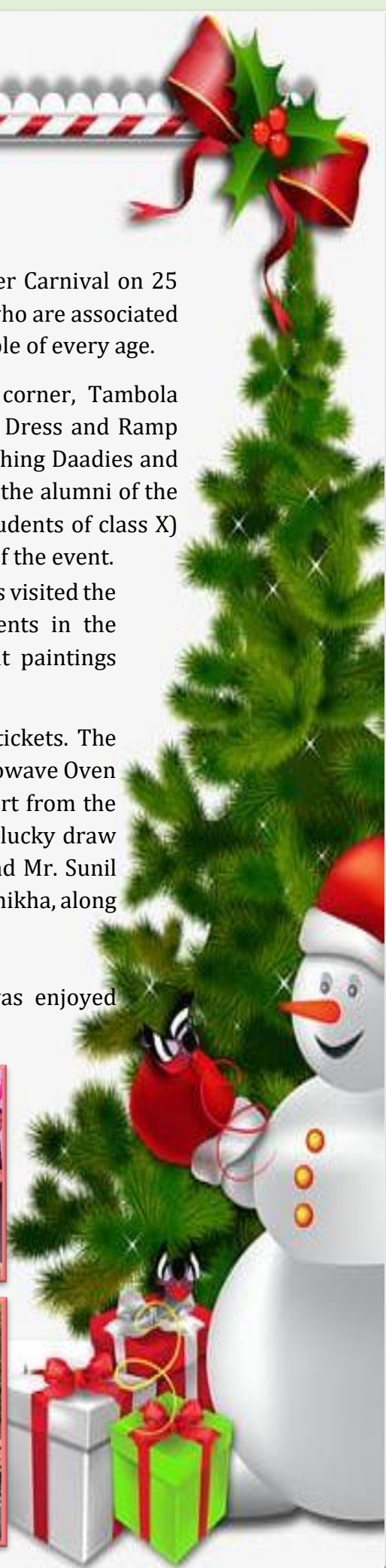

The students of class VII to X heard this session with rapt attention and participated very well in the questionnaire round.

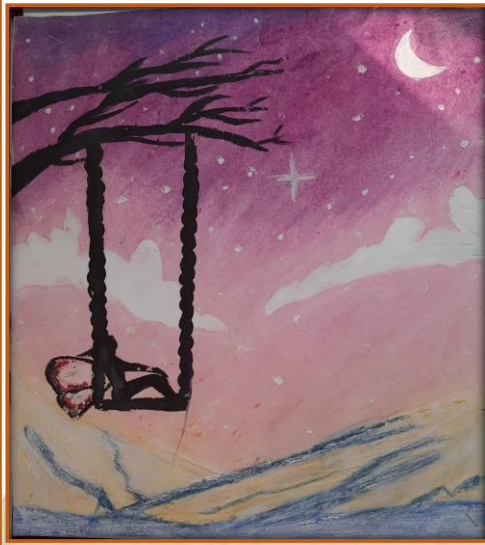
