The Sant Nirankari Mission seeks to reveal God realization, also known as Nirankar to all human beings irrespective of their religious faith.

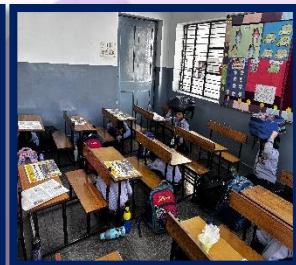

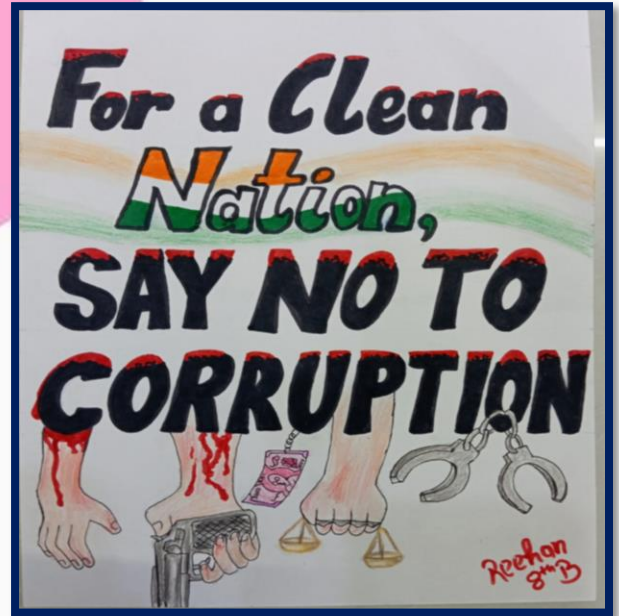

CONSTITUTION DAY

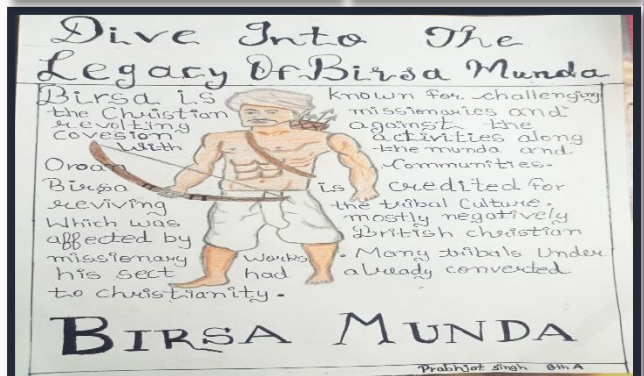
Cultivation of mind should be the ultimate aim of human existence. ~ B.R. Ambedkar

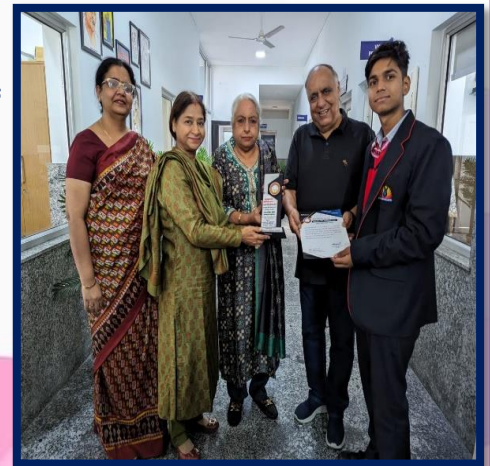

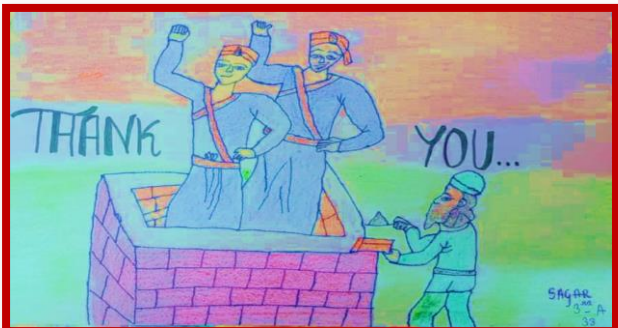
DANCE COMPETITION

The participants were divided into three categories:

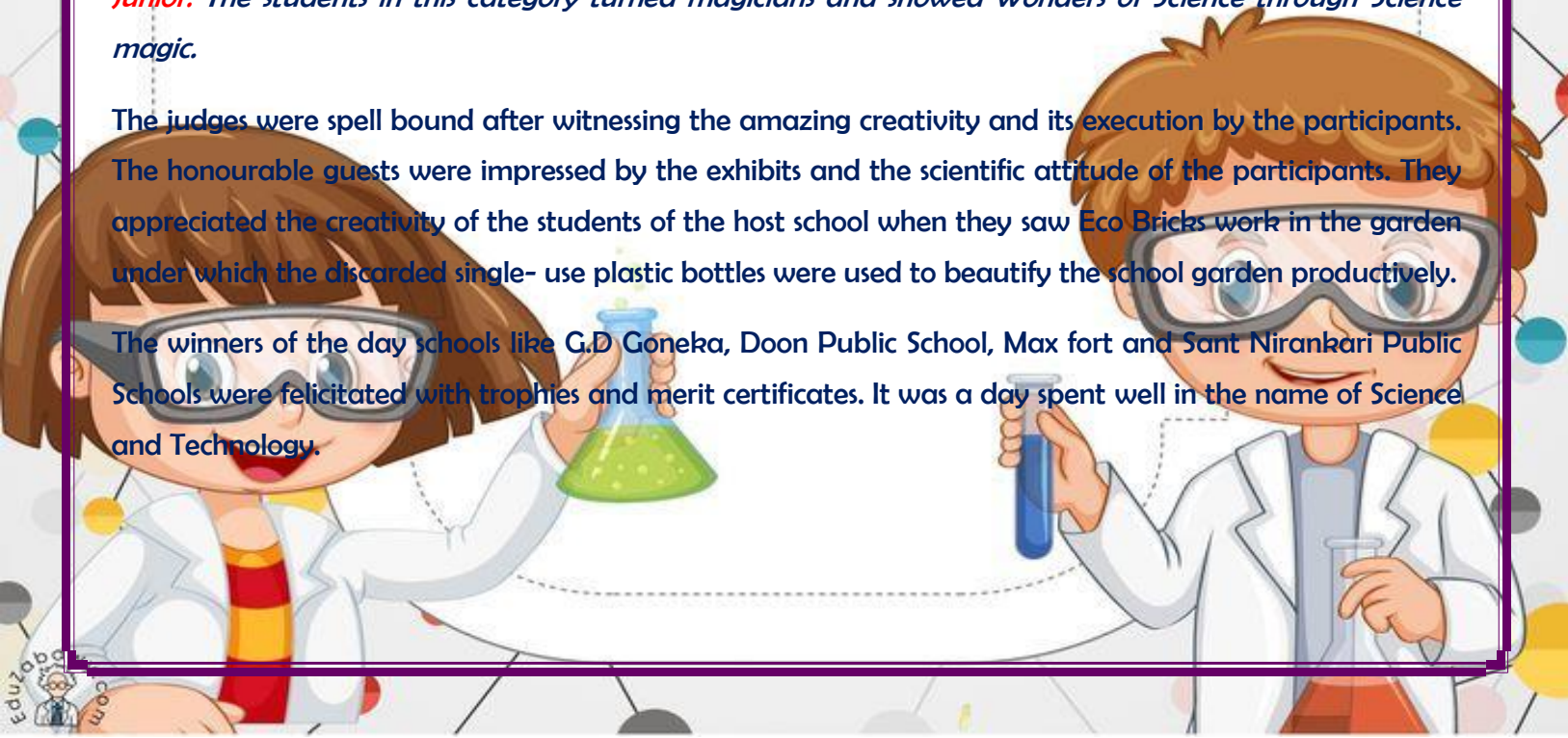
Senior: *The students under this category prepared their exhibits on the theme- Robotics and AI.*

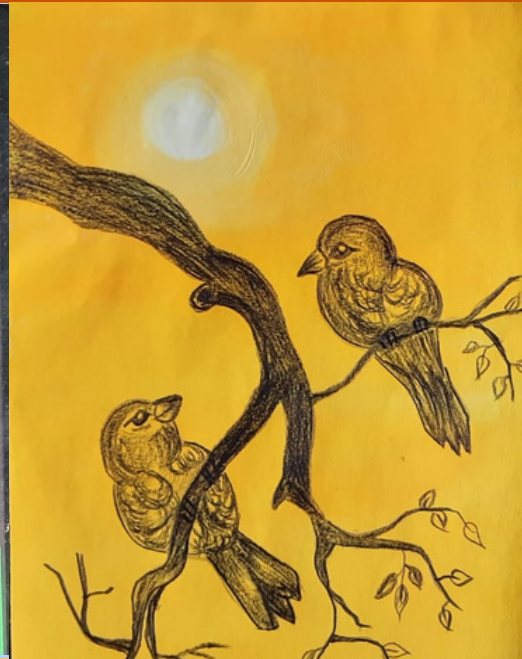

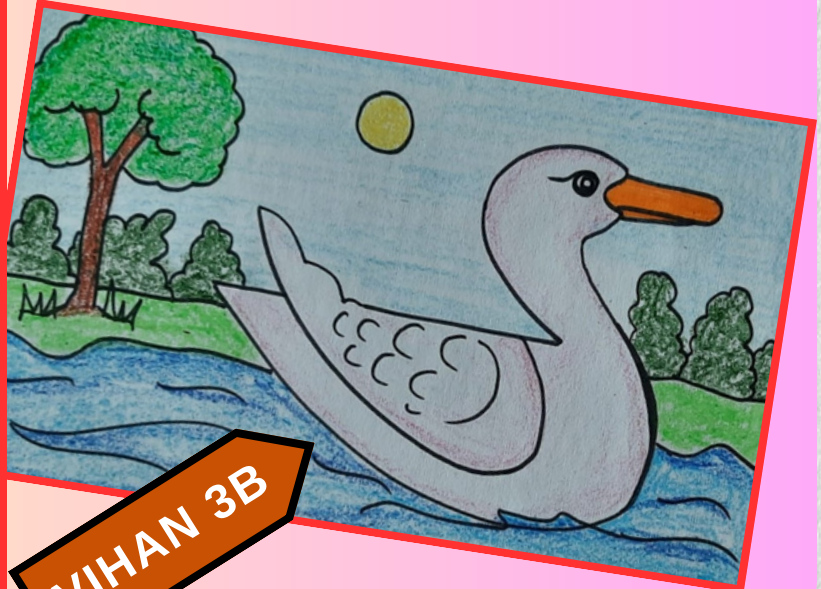
