


AMBEDKAR JAYANTI

She motivated parents to adopt a problem solving approach through following:

Concludingly, she guided the parents to improve their own overall health which will result in reducing stress and anxiety at home front as well as at their workplace. The session ended with a discussion round in which the parents asked their queries and were duly satisfied with the solutions.



HANDLING DIFFICULT CLASSROOM SITUATIONS

The real challenges faced by the teachers are handling difficult classroom situations and this was the topic of the workshop organized for teachers by Fortis Health Care on 29th May 2024 in the premises of Sant Nirankari Public School, Avtar Enclave. She made all the teachers aware about ABC Analysis Sheet which can help teachers to handle different behaviours of a few students, if any, in a classroom. She even suggested how to make changes in such students' behaviour through positive feedback and praising the students verbally in case of any slightest improvement. The teachers were guided to take care of the students' short attention span, give smaller and clear instructions steps wise. Such students can be taught social skills through different techniques. The workshop ended with a query round which was quite interactive and really beneficial for all the teachers.





GOOD HANDWRITING

Our school organised a workshop on 'Pencil Manufacturing and Good handwriting' by Apsara Platinum Pencils.
